The Ban Xaisom Boun School building works began in year 2000 and the school building was never completed. Only ground and roof are finish.

Every year requests to the District Authority and Ministry of Education were sent. No answers were received.

(In year 2000, villagers were requested to build tables and chairs for classrooms.)

The project includes a School Garden and a Pig-Farm (10 animals).

To complete the school building with brick walls, doors and windows, rebuild sanitary and ground water adduction.

To provide standard school equipments (Tables, benches, blackboards)

To build a school farm and a garden to learn about agriculture and livestock.
